The films of Hirokazu Koreeda have long featured in screenings by KFC and KFF. He seems to capture the innocence and magic of childhood in films such as I Wish, and Like Father, Like Son. For Our Little Sister, Koreeda takes his source material from Tales from a Seaside Town an ongoing saga published monthly in the Japanese woman's manga Flowers Magazine.

Our Little Sister is at once a touching tale of both womanhood and sisterhood, centering on three siblings of varying personality – the austere one, the adventurous one, the aberrant one – who live together among the memories of a crumbling family home. The arrival of a younger half-sister provokes a reexamination both their lives and the charred remains of the bridges

burned in the past – familial pain that is glimpsed just below the formalities.

Despite all the emotional struggles and dilemmas carried by the characters, the story conveys tranquility and generosity while some scenes mirror the pure joys and pleasures life is made of. Classic Koreeda indeed.

Rich in detail and essence, the optimistic "Our Little Sister" follows the combination of amiable tones and social analysis, so characteristic of Ozu and Shimizu. It confirms Koreeda as one of the best Japanese filmmaker working today.
