'For the last 40 the years, photographer Sebastião Salgado has been travelling through the continents, in the footsteps of an ever-changing humanity. He has witnessed some of the major events of our recent history; international conflicts, starvation and exodus. He is now embarking on the discovery of pristine territories, of wild fauna and flora, and of grandiose landscapes as

part of a huge photographic project, which is a tribute to the planet's beauty. Sebastião Salgado's life and work are revealed to us by his son, Juliano, who went with him during his last travels, and by Wim Wenders, himself a photographer' – Rotten Tomatoes

Director Wim Wenders claims to have been a fan of Sebastião Salgado's photos for most of his life: this is his tribute to Salgado's work. Following him around the world as he does this huge project allows Wenders to bring out the underlying thinking behind Salgado's work. The resulting film is as beautiful as the original photographs and gained Wenders an Oscar nomination for the best Documentary
